FREDERICK R. KLEPSCH, M.D., age 63 of Crown Point, passed away Saturday, August 3, 2013.

He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Mary Jo; four children: Kyle (Nikki) Klepsch of Crown Point, Kurt (Taylor) Klepsch of Valparaiso, Casey Klepsch of Chicago, Katelin (Kyle) Nelson of New York; four grandchildren: Hudson, Carter, Lily, and Evie; two sisters: Kathryn (James) McMillan of Bloomington, IN, Martha (John) Byrne of Munster. Preceded in death by his parents, Alfred and Elizabeth Klepsch.

Dr. Klepsch was a member of Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church, Crown Point and attended St. Mary Catholic Church, Crown Point. He was a graduate of East Chicago Washington High School, Purdue University and Indiana University Medical School. He completed his Orthopedic Residency at Rush University Medical Center. Dr. Klepsch was a member of the John Purdue Club and was an avid sports fan. He enjoyed fishing and being with his family.
